ORDER

1
2 Having considered Plaintiffs' Statement Regarding Settlement Compliance and good
3 appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

4 1. The Settlement Administrator ("KCC") shall increase the per-class member
5 settlement payment to \$750. KCC is authorized to make a supplemental payment to those class
6 members (or their successors) who were previously sent settlement checks to increase the overall
7 payment to \$750. KCC is further authorized to make \$750 payments to additional class members
8 (or their successors) who were not previously sent settlement checks and who make requests for
9 payment prior to October 15, 2017.

10 2. KCC is authorized to take reasonable steps to encourage class members (or their
11 successors) to cash previously-issued settlement checks, including without limitation, sending
12 reminder notices to such persons.

13 3. KCC shall be paid \$36,169.50 from the Settlement Fund for settlement
14 administration work completed to date. KCC shall be paid additional fees not to exceed \$42,934 for
15 work to be performed to complete settlement administration, upon presentation of appropriate
16 invoices that are approved by counsel.

17 4. The balance of the Settlement Fund -- net of the above-referenced settlement
18 payments to class members (or successors) and KCC administration expenses -- shall be held in an
19 interest-bearing account, pending further Court order.

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
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1 5. The hearing on the Final Compliance Report and hearing on Plaintiffs' motion for
2 additional attorneys' fees and costs is set for 11/8, 2017 at 2:30. The Final
3 Compliance Report shall be filed and served five court days prior to that hearing date. Plaintiffs'
4 motion for additional fees and costs shall be filed in accordance with the Code of Civil Procedure.

5 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**


